Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Consult with clients, colleagues and collaborators to gain understanding of system enhancements or modifications of existing programs to maintain software functionality.
- Work closely with all teams to define specifications, develop code and test software for defined projects and ensure timely completion. These projects may include interfaces with third party vendors wanting to interface with our software.
- Perform system enhancements and upgrades to customers' data systems to deliver latest software and hardware improvement.
- Perform data conversions for customers migrating from another data processing system to the Sharetec software. This involves programming the data mapping process and custom programming requested by the customer. This frequently involves modifications to online interfaces such as debit cards and internet/mobile banking.
- Maintain historical records by documenting program development and revisions. Identify opportunities that can improve efficiency of business processes.
- Assist sales effort as needed, including researching functionality improvements and enhancing demonstration systems.
- Maintain professional and technical knowledge by attending educational workshops; reviewing professional publications, etc.
- Maintain confidentiality of customer data with regards to the information being processed, stored or accessed.
